Cas and Jonesy are two Aussie Explorers constantly pushing the boundaries of human endurance.

On the 26th January 2012, they made history by completing the longest unsupported polar expedition of all time. In 100 years of polar exploration no-one had EVER walked from the edge of Antarctica to the South Pole and back without assistance. Many had tried, none had succeeded. After 89 gruelling days they made it back to the coast after having skied 2275km with everything they needed to survive in the harshest environment on Earth.

Four years earlier they Crossed the Ditch - paddling 3318km

without assistance across the Tasman Sea for another world first. They braved 10 metre swells, howling winds, endured severe food and sleep deprivation and adverse winds and currents. They became the first kayakers to cross the Tasman Sea as well as becoming the longest transoceanic double kayak expedition. Staggering upon the shores of New Zealand, the adventurers were sunburnt, bearded, underweight, and physically and mentally wasted...but most of all happy to be alive.

The boys are highly regarded as two of Australia's premier public speakers and have written & produced four award winning books and documentaries about their expeditions.



Directions to Dockside



Via Foot For Dockside

Walk down Market Street past the Darling Park monorail station on your right. Go down the escalators onto the Pyrmont Pedestrian Bridge level and turn left.

For Star room & Ice Cube Seafood Grill

Walk down Druitt Street, at the bottom walk across the pedestrian bridge to Cockle Bay Wharf and turn left, once on the promenade – the IMAX theatre is straight ahead.

Taxi Drop Off For Dockside

Ask to be dropped off at Cockle Bay Wharf under the blue canvas awning. The driver needs to take Wheat Road by keeping left going past the Imax Theatre. Take the escalators up one level to Dockside and two levels to L'Aqua.

For Star room & Ice Cube Seafood Grill

Ask to be dropped off at The IMAX Theatre.

Via Train For Dockside

Alight at Town Hall Station, and follow the directions as above.

For Star room & Ice Cube Seafood Grill Alight at Town Hall Station, and follow the directions as above.

Via Car

Turn left into Murray Street at the Harbourside intersection of Harris Street (towards the Novotel).

The Harbourside Car park is approximately 150 meters on the left hand side. Once parked, there is a walkway which will take you across to Darling Harbour (between the Sydney Convention Centre and the Harbourside Shopping Complex).

Dockside & L'Aqua are just opposite on the City side of Darling Harbour and Star room & Ice Cube Seafood Grill are in the IMAX Theatre complex to your left.

Or alternately, Darling Park car park is located at 201 Sussex Street. We recommend this car park for evening & weekend events.
